Dilated Retinal Examination

The doctors at The Eye Doctor LLC strongly recommend a dilated retinal examination.

- This allows the doctor to view the light sensitive tissue lining the inside of your eyes. The doctor looks for retinal problems including:
 - macular degeneration
 - glaucoma
 - retinal holes or detachments
 - tumors
 - retinal complications from diseases such as diabetes, stroke or high blood pressure

These conditions can lead to serious health problems including partial loss of vision or blindness, and often develop without warning and progress with no symptoms. Often times, early detection of eye related problems can save vision.

EARLY DETECTION IS CRUCIAL!

Dilation involves the use of eye drops to dilate your pupils, allowing the doctor to view inside your eye. These drops may cause blurred vision and light sensitivity for several hours. Your insurance may cover retinal dilation, so be sure to let us know about your insurance coverage.
